AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237, No.111), entitled

2 "An act specifically authorizing collective bargaining 3 between policemen and firemen and their public employers; providing for arbitration in order to settle disputes, and 5 requiring compliance with collective bargaining agreements and findings of arbitrators, "restricting membership on the 6 7 board of arbitration to certain individuals. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 4(b) of the act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237, No.111), referred to as the Policemen and Firemen 11 12 Collective Bargaining Act, is amended to read: 13 Section 4. 14 The board of arbitration shall be composed of three 15 persons, one appointed by the public employer, one appointed by 16 the body of policemen or firemen involved, and a third member to 17 be agreed upon by the public employer and such policemen or firemen. When a political subdivision of this Commonwealth is 18 the public employer, the three members of the board of 19 20 arbitration, wherever possible, shall all be residents of the

- 1 county in which the political subdivision is located. The
- 2 members of the board representing the public employer and the
- 3 policemen or firemen shall be named within five days from the
- 4 date of the request for the appointment of such board. If, after
- 5 a period of ten days from the date of the appointment of the two
- 6 arbitrators appointed by the public employer and by the
- 7 policemen or firemen, the third arbitrator has not been selected
- 8 by them, then either arbitrator may request the American
- 9 Arbitration Association, or its successor in function, to
- 10 furnish a list of three members of said association who are
- 11 residents of Pennsylvania from which the third arbitrator shall
- 12 be selected. The arbitrator appointed by the public employer
- 13 shall eliminate one name from the list within five days after
- 14 publication of the list, following which the arbitrator
- 15 appointed by the policemen or firemen shall eliminate one name
- 16 from the list within five days thereafter. The individual whose
- 17 name remains on the list shall be the third arbitrator and shall
- 18 act as chairman of the board of arbitration. The board of
- 19 arbitration thus established shall commence the arbitration
- 20 proceedings within ten days after the third arbitrator is
- 21 selected and shall make its determination within thirty days
- 22 after the appointment of the third arbitrator.
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
