## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for
- distribution of controlled substances forfeitures in cities
- 4 of the first class.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 6801(f) and (g) of Title 42 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 6801. Loss of property rights to Commonwealth.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (f) Use of cash or proceeds of property.--[Cash] Except as
- 12 provided for in subsection (q), cash or proceeds of forfeited
- 13 property transferred to the custody of the district attorney
- 14 pursuant to subsection (e) shall be placed in the operating fund
- 15 of the county in which the district attorney is elected. The
- 16 appropriate county authority shall immediately release from the
- 17 operating fund, without restriction, a like amount for the use

- 1 of the district attorney enforcing the provisions of The
- 2 Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act. The entity
- 3 having budgetary control shall not anticipate future forfeitures
- 4 or proceeds therefrom in adoption and approval of the budget for
- 5 the district attorney.
- 6 (g) Distribution of property among law enforcement
- 7 authorities. -- If both municipal and State law enforcement
- 8 authorities were substantially involved in effecting the
- 9 seizure, the court having jurisdiction over the forfeiture
- 10 proceedings shall equitably distribute the property between the
- 11 district attorney and the Attorney General. <u>In cities of the</u>
- 12 first class, 40% of the total cash or proceeds of property
- 13 forfeited shall be distributed to the following entities:
- 14 (1) City police department.
- 15 (2) Nonprofit community-based organizations that are
- actively confronting the drug problem and are providing
- 17 educational, health care, housing and community development
- 18 services.
- 19 (3) Nonprofit agencies providing inpatient or outpatient
- 20 <u>drug rehabilitation programs and/or crime prevention.</u>
- 21 The Governor's Office shall promulgate regulations involving the
- 22 distribution of funds within cities of the first class pursuant
- 23 to this subsection.

- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
