10	(c) Reimbursement of expenses of salvorUpon receipt
11	within six months of evidence that a salvor has removed an
12	abandoned vehicle upon the request of a police department, the
13	department shall pay to the salvor from the Motor License Fund
14	the sum of [\$15] <u>\$25</u> for the expenses incurred in the removal
15	and towing of the abandoned vehicle. No portion of [\$15] $\frac{$25}{}$
16	payment or any separate consideration shall be reimbursed or
17	paid to any government agency or municipality by the salvor.
