## AN ACT

- 1 Providing loans to municipalities; creating a loan fund;
- 2 conferring powers upon the Department of Community Affairs;
- 3 and making an appropriation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Local
- 8 Government Capital Project Loan Fund Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Data processing equipment." Any computer, terminal,
- 14 printer, expansion unit, display unit, software or related

- 1 component of a data processing system.
- 2 "Department." The Department of Community Affairs of the
- 3 Commonwealth.
- 4 "Equipment." Any truck, car, bulldozer, backhoe, grader,
- 5 highlift, forklift, street sweeper, other mechanized vehicle or
- 6 data processing equipment.
- 7 "Fund." The Local Government Capital Project Loan Fund.
- 8 "Facilities." Any structure used to house offices or
- 9 equipment and the land on which the structure is situated.
- 10 "Municipality." Any borough, town, first class township or
- 11 second class township.
- 12 Section 3. Assistance to municipalities.
- 13 (a) Purposes; amounts.--The department is hereby authorized,
- 14 upon application of a municipality, to make loans to the
- 15 municipality for the following purposes and in the following
- 16 amounts:
- 17 (1) Purchasing equipment. The amount of a loan made for
- 18 purchasing equipment shall not exceed \$50,000 for any single
- 19 piece of equipment or 50% of the total cost of the piece of
- 20 equipment, whichever is less.
- 21 (2) Purchasing, constructing, renovating or
- 22 rehabilitating facilities. The amount of a loan made for
- 23 purchasing, constructing, renovating or rehabilitating
- facilities shall not exceed \$100,000 for any single facility
- or 50% of the total cost for purchasing, constructing,
- 26 renovating or rehabilitating the facility, whichever is less.
- 27 (b) Terms.--Loans made by the department shall be for a
- 28 period of not more than ten years. Loans shall be subject to the
- 29 payment of interest at 2% per annum and shall be subject to such
- 30 security as shall be determined by the department. The total

- 1 amount of interest earned by the investment or reinvestment of
- 2 all or any part of the principal of any loan shall be returned
- 3 to the department and transferred to the fund and shall not be
- 4 credited as payment of principal or interest on the loan. The
- 5 minimum amount of any loan shall be \$1,000.
- 6 (c) Financial statement.--Every application for a loan under
- 7 this act shall be accompanied by a financial statement of the
- 8 municipality and a financial plan to show how the loan will be
- 9 repaid. Every application shall be accompanied by evidence
- 10 sufficient to show that all costs except the amount of the loan
- 11 will be met by assets or revenues of the municipality, grants or
- 12 loans from other sources, or in-kind contributions or services.
- 13 (d) Limitations.--Loans under this act shall be used for
- 14 purchasing equipment and for purchasing, constructing,
- 15 renovating or rehabilitating facilities and shall not be used
- 16 for operating expenses or for the refinancing or reduction of
- 17 any debt or obligation incurred prior to the effective date of
- 18 this act.
- 19 (e) Regulations.--Loans made by the department shall be paid
- 20 from the fund to municipalities in accordance with rules and
- 21 regulations promulgated by the department.
- 22 (f) Interest.--All payments of interest on loans and the
- 23 principal thereof shall be deposited by the department in the
- 24 fund.
- 25 Section 4. Local Government Capital Project Loan Fund.
- 26 (a) Fund.--There is hereby created a special fund in the
- 27 Treasury Department, to be known as the Local Government Capital
- 28 Project Loan Fund, to which shall be credited all appropriations
- 29 made by the General Assembly, other than appropriations for
- 30 expenses of administering this act, or grants from other sources

- 1 to the department as well as repayment of principal and interest
- 2 on loans made pursuant to this act.
- 3 (b) Revolving fund.--The department shall routinely
- 4 requisition from the fund such amounts as shall be allocated by
- 5 the department for loans to municipalities pursuant to this act.
- 6 When and as the amounts so allocated by the department as loans
- 7 to municipalities are repaid to the department pursuant to the
- 8 terms of the agreements made and entered into with the
- 9 department, the department shall pay such amounts into the fund,
- 10 it being the intent of this act that the fund shall operate as a
- 11 revolving fund whereby all appropriations and payments made
- 12 thereto may be applied and reapplied for the purposes of this
- 13 act.
- 14 Section 5. Powers and duties of the department.
- 15 In addition to the powers and duties conferred upon the
- 16 department under other provisions of law, the department shall
- 17 have the power and duty to:
- 18 (1) Lend money for the purposes authorized by this act
- over a term of years, but in no case in excess of ten years.
- 20 (2) Accept grants from the Federal Government and any
- other individual, agency or government for use in the fund.
- 22 (3) Prescribe the form of the application for a loan
- 23 pursuant to this act.
- 24 (4) Advise a municipality regarding the financial
- ability of the municipality to purchase equipment or to
- 26 purchase, construct, renovate or rehabilitate facilities.
- 27 (5) Assist a municipality in taking advantage of joint
- 28 purchasing arrangements and of opportunities to purchase
- 29 surplus equipment from the Commonwealth or other political
- 30 subdivisions.

- 1 (6) Require security for a loan, if determined to be
- 2 necessary.
- 3 (7) Specify priority of liens against any facilities or
- 4 equipment purchased by a municipality using funds loaned
- 5 pursuant to this act, if determined to be necessary.
- 6 (8) Establish a schedule which provides at least an
- 7 annual opportunity for municipalities to apply for, and
- 8 receive, loans.
- 9 Section 6. Ranking of applications.
- 10 Whenever the department determines that there will not be
- 11 enough money in the fund to make loans to all of the
- 12 municipalities expected to submit eligible applications during
- 13 an application period, the department shall rank the
- 14 applications in order of priority to determine which loans shall
- 15 be made first. A system of ranking shall be established for the
- 16 purposes of this section by regulation and shall provide for
- 17 consideration of factors such as whether the municipality has
- 18 previously received a loan pursuant to this act; the ability of
- 19 the municipality to purchase equipment or purchase, construct,
- 20 renovate or rehabilitate facilities without a loan pursuant to
- 21 this act; and the impact of the purchase of equipment or the
- 22 purchase, construction, renovation or rehabilitation of
- 23 facilities on the health, safety or welfare of the residents of
- 24 the municipality.
- 25 Section 7. Appropriation.
- The sum of \$7,000,000 is hereby appropriated to the fund from
- 27 the sum of \$140,000,000 appropriated by the act of July 3, 1987
- 28 (P.L.459, No.9A), known as the General Appropriation Act of
- 29 1987, for local tax reform during a special session of the
- 30 General Assembly.

- 1 Section 8. Effective date.
- 2 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
