AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the manufacture, sale or
3 use of aerosol spray devices.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 7326. Manufacture, sale or use of aerosol devices.

9 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits a misdemeanor of the
10 second degree if he manufactures or sells a device having an
11 aerosol spray.

12 (b) Penalty.--A person convicted under this section shall be
13 sentenced to pay a fine of \$5,000.

14 (c) Confiscation of devices.--All aerosol devices of a
15 person convicted under this section shall be confiscated and
16 turned over to the Department of Environmental Resources for
17 disposal in a manner which is environmentally sound.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in one year.
