Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further defining the offense of ethnic 2 3 intimidation to include sexual orientation; and changing the designation of the offense. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2710 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 2710. {Ethnic intimidation[.]} Bias related offenses. AND 10 OTHER BIAS-RELATED OFFENSES. 11 Offense defined .-- A person commits [the offense of ethnic intimidation] a bias related offense AN OFFENSE UNDER 13 THIS SECTION if, with malicious intention toward the race, color, religion [or], national origin or sexual orientation of 15 another individual or group of individuals, he commits an

- 13 classes of offenses) than the classification of the other

- 17 THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION:
- 18 "MALICIOUS INTENTION." THE intention to commit any act, the
- 19 commission of which is a necessary element of any offense
- 20 referred to in subsection (a) motivated by hatred toward the
- 21 race, color, religion [or], national origin or sexual
- 22 <u>orientation</u> of another individual or group of individuals.
- 23 "SEXUAL ORIENTATION." CONSENSUAL HOMOSEXUALITY OR
- 24 <u>HETEROSEXUALITY</u>.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
