## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for exemptions from special
- 3 permit requirements.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4963 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 4963. Exemptions for vehicles used in State highway
- 9 construction.
- 10 (a) General exemption. -- No special permit shall be required
- 11 for movement across, upon or along State [or State-aid] highways
- 12 for an oversize or overweight [vehicles of a] vehicle, of an
- 13 authorized contractor [used for the] or of the department,
- 14 currently involved in the authorized construction or improvement
- 15 of such highways.
- 16 (b) Restriction. -- This section shall not apply to roads or
- 17 bridges posted under section 4902(a) (relating to restrictions
- 18 on use of highways and bridges). This section shall not exempt a

- 1 <u>vehicle from the permit requirements of this chapter for</u>
- 2 movement across, upon or along highways leading to the jobsite.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 3
