## AN ACT

Authorizing and directing the Department of General Services, with the approval of the Governor and the Secretary of Environmental Resources, to convey to Morris Township a road situate in Morris Township, Tioga County, Pennsylvania.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. The Department of General Services, with the approval of the Governor and the Secretary of Environmental Resources, is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to grant and convey to Morris Township the following road (known as Love Hollow Road) situate in Morris Township, Tioga County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning on the existing center line of the Wilson Hill Road T-460 at the intersection of the Love Hollow Road within lands of Amos B. Witmer; thence by the existing center line of the Love Hollow Road by lands of Amos B. Witmer north 76 degrees 54 minutes 50 seconds east 104.59 feet to a point on the existing center line of the Love Hollow Road at the common boundary of
lands of Amos B. Witmer and lands of the Department of Environmental Resources; thence by the existing center line of the said Love Hollow Road the following 24 courses and distances within lands of the Department of Environmental Resources:
(1) south 85 degrees 28 minutes 01 second east a distance of 60.08 feet;
(2) south 45 degrees 12 minutes 08 seconds east a distance of 118.20 feet;
(3) south 30 degrees 32 minutes 57 seconds east a distance of 111.06 feet;
(4) south 60 degrees 50 minutes 55 seconds east a distance of 204.61 feet;
(5) south 88 degrees 43 minutes 18 seconds east a distance of 113.70 feet;
(6) north 75 degrees 23 minutes 28 seconds east a distance of 51.43 feet;
(7) north 70 degrees 52 minutes 11 seconds east a distance of 210.37 feet;
(8) north 74 degrees 05 minutes 26 seconds east a distance of 180.55 feet;
(9) north 79 degrees 15 minutes 49 seconds east a distance of 133.66 feet;
(10) south 86 degrees 10 minutes 08 seconds east a distance of 99.17 feet;
(11) south 81 degrees 09 minutes 08 seconds east a distance of 179.39 feet;
(12) south 82 degrees 57 minutes 25 seconds east a distance of 104.56 feet;
(13) south 77 degrees 04 minutes 47 seconds east a distance of 145.60 feet;

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(2) south 02 degrees 18 minutes 47 seconds west a distance of 43.91 feet;
(3) south 26 degrees 03 minutes 41 seconds east a distance of 75.20 feet;
(4) south 81 degrees 07 minutes 22 seconds east a distance of 50.00 feet;
to a point on the existing center line of the Love Hollow Road at the common boundary of lands aforementioned and lands of Brian J. Magness; thence by the existing center line of the said Love Hollow Road by lands of Carl Levan and lands of Brian J. Magness the following four courses and distances:
(1) south 81 degrees 07 minutes 22 seconds east a distance of 53.04 feet;
(2) north 47 degrees 54 minutes 25 seconds east a distance of 85.32 feet;
(3) north 25 degrees 15 minutes 27 seconds east a distance of 77.73 feet;
(4) north 08 degrees 27 minutes 56 seconds west a distance of 25.23 feet;
to a point on the existing center line of the Love Hollow Road at the common boundary of lands aforementioned and the Department of Environmental Resources; thence by the existing center line of the said Love Hollow Road within lands of the Department of Environmental Resources the following 28 courses and distances:
(1) north 08 degrees 27 minutes 56 seconds west a distance of 98.33 feet;
(2) north 15 degrees 38 minutes 13 seconds west a distance of 334.12 feet;
(3) north 11 degrees 19 minutes 17 seconds west a distance
persons, whether or not appearing of record, for any portion of the land.

Section 3. The deed of conveyance shall contain a clause that the property conveyed shall be used for public purposes by Morris Township and if at any time Morris Township or its successor conveys the property or permits the property to be used for any purpose other than those specified in this section, the title to the property shall immediately revert to and revest in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 4. The deed of conveyance shall be approved as provided by law and shall be executed by the Secretary of General Services in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 5. Costs and fees incidental to the conveyance shall be borne by the grantee.

Section 6. This act shall take effect immediately.
