## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 1, 1988 (P.L.82, No.16), entitled "An 2 act providing for the establishment, implementation and 3 administration of the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority; imposing powers and duties on a board of trustees; 5 transferring the rights, powers, duties and obligations of the Water Facilities Loan Board to the Pennsylvania 7 Infrastructure Investment Authority; providing for the 8 issuance of notes and bonds; providing for financial assistance and for a comprehensive water facilities plan; 9 10 authorizing a referendum to incur indebtedness; making an 11 appropriation; and making repeals, "further providing for 12 financial assistance.
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. Section 10(a) and (b) of the act of March 1, 1988
- 16 (P.L.82, No.16), known as the Pennsylvania Infrastructure
- 17 Investment Authority Act, are amended by adding paragraphs to
- 18 read:
- 19 Section 10. Financial assistance.

- 1 (a) Criteria for obtaining assistance.--In reviewing
- 2 applications for financial assistance, the authority shall
- 3 consider:

- 5 (8) Whether the proposed project encourages the
- 6 <u>development of housing that is affordable to individuals of</u>
- 7 low to moderate income.
- 8 (b) Financing priorities. -- In assigning priorities for
- 9 projects, the board shall consult with the Department of
- 10 Commerce and the department. In addition to any requirements of
- 11 Federal law imposed on the use of Federal funds, the board shall
- 12 determine priorities based on factors which include, but are not
- 13 limited to:

- 16 <u>affordable to individuals of low to moderate income.</u>

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
