## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, extending the expiration date of the
- 3 Pennsylvania Veterans' Memorial Commission; AND MAKING AN
- 4 APPROPRIATION.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1906 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 1906. Expiration of chapter.
- 10 This chapter shall expire [on December 31, 1990] upon
- 11 completion of construction of the monument described in section
- 12 1905(b) (relating to Pennsylvania Veterans' Memorial Trust
- 13 <u>Fund</u>).
- 14 SECTION 2. THE SUM OF \$1,000,000, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY <--
- 15 BE NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE PENNSYLVANIA

- 1 VETERANS' MEMORIAL TRUST FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE
- 2 MONUMENT DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1905(B) (RELATING TO PENNSYLVANIA
- 3 VETERANS' MEMORIAL TRUST FUND).
- 4 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . This act shall take effect immediately.
