1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, extending the expiration date of the
3 Pennsylvania Veterans' Memorial Commission; AND MAKING AN
4 APPROPRIATION. <—

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1906 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 1906. Expiration of chapter.

10 This chapter shall expire [on December 31, 1990] upon
11 completion of construction of the monument described in section
12 1905(b) (relating to Pennsylvania Veterans' Memorial Trust
13 Fund).

14 SECTION 2. THE SUM OF \$1,000,000, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY <—
15 BE NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE PENNSYLVANIA

1 VETERANS' MEMORIAL TRUST FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE
2 MONUMENT DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1905(B) (RELATING TO PENNSYLVANIA
3 VETERANS' MEMORIAL TRUST FUND).

4 Section ~~2~~ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
