## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 28, 1988 (P.L.556, No.101), entitled "An act providing for planning for the processing and disposal of municipal waste; requiring counties to submit 2 3 4 plans for municipal waste management systems within their boundaries; authorizing grants to counties and municipalities 6 for planning, resource recovery and recycling; imposing and 7 collecting fees; establishing certain rights for host 8 municipalities; requiring municipalities to implement 9 recycling programs; requiring Commonwealth agencies to procure recycled materials; imposing duties; granting powers 10 to counties and municipalities; authorizing the Environmental 11 12 Quality Board to adopt regulations; authorizing the 13 Department of Environmental Resources to implement this act; 14 providing remedies; prescribing penalties; establishing a fund; and making repeals, "further providing for municipal 15 16 implementation of recycling programs in municipalities with 17 small populations or with low population densities. - hereby enacts as follows: 19
- 20 Section 1. Section 1501(b) of the act of July 28, 1988
- 21 (P.L.556, No.101), known as the Municipal Waste Planning,
- 22 Recycling and Waste Reduction Act, is amended and the section is
- 23 amended by adding a subsection to read:
- Section 1501. Municipal implementation of recycling programs. 24
- 25

- 1 (b) [Small] <u>Moderate</u> population.--Within three years after
- 2 the effective date of this act, each municipality other than a
- 3 county that has a population of more than 5,000 people but less
- 4 than 10,000 people, and which has a population density of more
- 5 than 300 people per square mile, shall establish and implement a
- 6 source-separation and collection program for recyclable
- 7 materials in accordance with this section. Population shall be
- 8 determined based on the most recent decennial census by the
- 9 Bureau of the Census of the United States Department of
- 10 Commerce.
- 11 (b.1) Small or low density population. -- Within four years
- 12 <u>after the effective date of this act, a municipality other than</u>
- 13 <u>a county that is not included under either subsection (a) or (b)</u>
- 14 shall establish and implement a source-separation and collection
- 15 program for recyclable materials in accordance with this
- 16 section.

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
