AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for the issuance of special registration
3 plates for veterans of the Korean War.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1350. Special plates for veterans of Korean War.

9 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the Korean
10 War, accompanied by a fee of \$20, which shall be in addition to
11 the annual registration fee, and by such documentation as the
12 department shall require by regulation, the department shall
13 issue to the person a special registration plate designating the

1 vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who is a veteran of
2 the Korean War. The special registration plate may be used only
3 on one passenger vehicle or one other vehicle with a registered
4 gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
