A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service
2 to work with Federal, State and local agencies in obtaining
3 and utilizing drug-related information in the possession of
4 those agencies; and memorializing Congress to provide for
5 forfeiture of property of deported drug offenders.

6 WHEREAS, Federal, State and local agencies frequently come
7 into possession of information which could be of service to the
8 United States Immigration and Naturalization Service; and

9 WHEREAS, Forfeiture of property would be a fitting punishment
10 for persons deported for drug offenses; therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
12 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the United States Immigration
13 and Naturalization Service to work with Federal, State and local
14 agencies in order to obtain and utilize any and all information
15 these agencies might have which would help the United States
16 Immigration and Naturalization Service in the war against drugs,

1 particularly information pertaining to the sale and use of drugs
2 by persons known to the Federal, State and local authorities;
3 and be it further

4 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
5 the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service, to the
6 presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each member
7 of Congress from Pennsylvania.
