11 knows no boundaries in terms of race, sex, economic status and

1 WHEREAS, President George Bush has repeatedly given emphasis
2 to the importance of volunteerism in his reference to the
3 "Thousand Points of Light"; and

4 WHEREAS, The private, nonprofit volunteer agency, Volunteer -
5 The National Center in Arlington, Virginia, has designated April
