Recognizing the valuable service performed by home health care 1 2 agencies. 3 WHEREAS, Home health care is a vital health care service available to citizens of this Commonwealth; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Home health care services are given to patients regardless of their race, religion, nationality or ability to 6 7 pay; and 8 WHEREAS, Home health care services enable patients to be treated at home, thereby keeping family members together; and 9 10 WHEREAS, Home health care fosters more rapid recovery, earlier hospital discharge and reduced admissions to 11 institutions; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Most persons prefer to remain with their families in 14 the comfort and security of their homes; and 15 WHEREAS, The number and variety of treatments and therapies

available to patients in their homes is increasing; and
WHEREAS, There is growing evidence that home health care is
an economical means of treating patients; therefore be it
RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives proclaim November
25 through December 1, 1990, as "Home Health Care Week" and ask
the citizens of this Commonwealth to do likewise in recognition
and appreciation of the valuable service provided by home health
care agencies.
