AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined, " regulating transfer of 21 prisoners. - 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. Section 902-B of the act of April 9, 1929
- 25 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929,
- 26 added April 9, 1990 (P.L.115, No.28), is amended to read:
- 27 Section 902-B. Power to Contract. -- (a) The Department of

- 1 Corrections may contract with the Federal Government for the
- 2 housing of inmates in Federal correctional facilities.
- 3 (b) Inmates shall be housed in Federal correctional
- 4 <u>facilities within Pennsylvania, however if insufficient space is</u>
- 5 available in Federal correctional facilities within
- 6 Pennsylvania, inmates may be transferred to Federal facilities
- 7 <u>which are located outside of Pennsylvania which are not more</u>
- 8 than one hundred fifty miles from the Pennsylvania border.
- 9 Section 2. Inmates transferred to Federal facilities outside
- 10 of Pennsylvania pursuant to the prison disturbances of October
- 11 1989, shall be relocated to Federal or State facilities in
- 12 Pennsylvania within six months of the effective date of this
- 13 act.
- 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
