## AN ACT

- 1 Excluding the sale of recyclable material from municipal
- 2 personal property sale restrictions.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Definitions.
- 6 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 7 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 8 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 9 "Municipality." Any county, city, borough, incorporated
- 10 town, township, SCHOOL DISTRICT or home rule municipality.
- 11 Section 2. Exclusion.
- 12 A municipality shall not be subject to requirements otherwise
- 13 imposed by law for the sale of personal property owned by the

- 1 municipality when selling recyclable material or material
- 2 separated, collected, recovered or created by recycling.
- 3 Section 3. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately. 4
