AN ACT

1 Excluding the sale of recyclable material from ~~municipal~~ <—
2 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION personal property sale restrictions <—
3 RELATING TO ADVERTISING AND BIDDING. <—

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Definitions.

7 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
8 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
9 context clearly indicates otherwise:

10 ~~"Municipality."~~ "POLITICAL SUBDIVISION." Any county, city, <—
11 borough, incorporated town, township, SCHOOL DISTRICT or home <—
12 rule municipality.

13 Section 2. Exclusion.

14 A ~~municipality~~ POLITICAL SUBDIVISION shall not be subject to <—

1 requirements OF ADVERTISING AND BIDDING otherwise imposed by law <—
2 for the sale of personal property owned by the ~~municipality~~ <—
3 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION when selling recyclable material or <—
4 material separated, collected, recovered or created by ~~recycling~~ <—
5 A RECYCLING PROGRAM AUTHORIZED BY THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. <—
6 Section 3. Effective date.
7 This act shall take effect immediately.
