AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, providing for the issuance of special registration  
3 plates to certain senior citizens to assist in curtailing  
4 automobile thefts.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1350. Senior citizens against theft plates.

10 (a) General rule.--On the application of a senior citizen  
11 vehicle owner who signs the waiver in subsection (b),  
12 accompanied by the appropriate fee, the department shall issue a  
13 special registration plate of distinctive color designating the  
14 licensed vehicle as belonging to a senior citizen who consents  
15 to any stoppage of that vehicle by a police officer without  
16 probable cause.

17 (b) Waiver.--The waiver required under subsection (a) shall

1 be in boldfaced writing and shall clearly state that the  
2 applicant, by signing the application and waiver, surrenders all  
3 rights to object to the stoppage of the licensed vehicle by any  
4 police officer at any time with or without probable cause. The  
5 waiver shall also state clearly that the applicant's signature  
6 binds any other operators or occupants of the licensed vehicle.

7       Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
