12	Section 1547.1. Adoption Information Within Health Course.	<
13	(a) Beginning with the school year 1991 1992, and each year	
14	thereafter, each public school student in grades kindergarten	
15	through twelve shall receive mandatory instruction about	
16	adoption within the health course of study required in	
17	accordance with State Board of Education regulations.	

1	(b) A sequential, age appropriate curriculum shall be	
2	developed by the State Board of Education which shall include,	
3	but not be limited to, emphasis on adoption as a positive family	
4	building option, impact of adoption on an adopted person's life	
5	and adoption as an alternative to a crisis pregnancy. The State	
6	Board of Education shall promulgate this curriculum as part of	
7	Department of Education regulations.	
8	(c) The curriculum shall be implemented in all school	
9	districts, with the exception that any school district may	
10	substitute its own curriculum if approved by the State Board of	
11	Education as meeting the objectives of this act. Provisions	
12	shall be made to assist school districts in acquiring the	
13	necessary materials for this instruction.
