A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- 2 of Pennsylvania, providing for four-year terms for members of
- 3 the House of Representatives and six-year terms for members
- 4 of the Senate.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby resolves as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 8 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 9 That section 3 of Article II be amended to read:
- 10 § 3. Terms of members.
- 11 Senators shall be elected for the term of [four] six years
- 12 and Representatives for the term of [two] four years.
- 13 Section 2. At the first general election after the adoption
- 14 of this amendment, representatives in odd-numbered districts
- 15 shall be elected for terms of four years and the representatives
- 16 in even-numbered districts shall be elected for terms of two
- 17 years. Sixteen senators shall be elected for terms of two years,

- 1 17 senators shall be elected for terms of four years and 17
- 2 senators shall be elected for terms of six years. The method of
- 3 selection of the senatorial districts which shall correspond to
- 4 the terms of two, four and six years shall be provided for by
- 5 the General Assembly.
