AN ACT

Amending the act of July 15, 1976 (P.L.1036, No.208), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act authorizing the indebtedness, with the 3 approval of the electors, of fifty million dollars for loans to volunteer fire companies, volunteer ambulance services and 4 volunteer rescue squads for the purpose of establishing or modernizing facilities to house fire fighting apparatus 7 equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles, and for 8 purchasing new fire fighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles, protective and communications equipment, 9 10 and any other accessory equipment necessary for the proper performance of such organizations' duties," increasing the 11 12 borrowing authority limit and eliminating a countersignature 13 and conforming certain provisions. FURTHER PROVIDING FOR 14 ASSISTANCE TO VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES, AMBULANCE SERVICES AND RESCUE SOUADS; INCREASING THE BORROWING AUTHORITY LIMIT; 15 ELIMINATING A COUNTERSIGNATURE; CONFORMING CERTAIN 16 17 PROVISIONS; AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 4 SECTION 1. SECTION 2 OF THE ACT OF JULY 15, 1976 (P.L.1036, <---
- 5 NO.208), KNOWN AS THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, AMBULANCE SERVICE
- 6 AND RESCUE SQUAD ASSISTANCE ACT, AMENDED MAY 11, 1982 (P.L.407,
- 7 NO.118), IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 8 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS; DECLARATION OF PURPOSE.--
- 9 (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AS A FACT THAT PURSUANT TO THE
- 10 PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7(A)(3) OF ARTICLE VIII OF THE
- 11 PENNSYLVANIA CONSTITUTION THE VOTERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH
- 12 APPROVED BY REFERENDA ON NOVEMBER 4, 1975, THE INCURRING OF
- 13 INDEBTEDNESS OF \$10,000,000 AND ON NOVEMBER 3, 1981, APPROVED
- 14 THE INCURRING OF AN ADDITIONAL \$15,000,000 OF INDEBTEDNESS AND
- 15 ON NOVEMBER 6, 1990, APPROVED THE INCURRING OF AN ADDITIONAL
- 16 \$25,000,000 OF INDEBTEDNESS FOR LOANS TO VOLUNTEER FIRE
- 17 COMPANIES, VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICES AND VOLUNTEER RESCUE
- 18 SQUADS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING OR MODERNIZING FACILITIES
- 19 TO HOUSE FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS EQUIPMENT, AMBULANCES, AND
- 20 RESCUE VEHICLES, AND FOR PURCHASING NEW FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS
- 21 EQUIPMENT, AMBULANCES, AND RESCUE VEHICLES, PROTECTIVE AND
- 22 COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT, AND ANY OTHER ACCESSORY EQUIPMENT
- 23 NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER PERFORMANCE OF SUCH ORGANIZATIONS'

- 25 (B) IT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS ACT TO IMPLEMENT SECTION 5 OF
- 26 THE ACT OF SEPTEMBER 25, 1975 (P.L.296, NO.95), ENTITLED "AN ACT
- 27 AUTHORIZING THE INDEBTEDNESS, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE ELECTORS,
- 28 OF TEN MILLION DOLLARS FOR LOANS TO VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES,
- 29 VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICES AND VOLUNTEER RESCUE SQUADS FOR THE
- 30 PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING OR MODERNIZING FACILITIES TO HOUSE FIRE

- 1 FIGHTING APPARATUS EQUIPMENT, AMBULANCES, AND RESCUE VEHICLES,
- 2 AND FOR PURCHASING NEW FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS EQUIPMENT,
- 3 AMBULANCES, AND RESCUE VEHICLES, PROTECTIVE AND COMMUNICATIONS
- 4 EQUIPMENT, AND ANY OTHER ACCESSORY EQUIPMENT NECESSARY FOR THE
- 5 PROPER PERFORMANCE OF SUCH ORGANIZATIONS' DUTIES," AND SECTION 5
- 6 OF THE ACT OF JUNE 30, 1981 (P.L.138, NO.44), ENTITLED "AN ACT
- 7 AUTHORIZING THE INDEBTEDNESS, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE ELECTORS,
- 8 OF \$15,000,000 FOR LOANS TO VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES, VOLUNTEER
- 9 AMBULANCE SERVICES AND VOLUNTEER RESCUE SQUADS FOR THE PURPOSE
- 10 OF ESTABLISHING OR MODERNIZING FACILITIES TO HOUSE FIREFIGHTING
- 11 APPARATUS EQUIPMENT, AMBULANCES, AND RESCUE VEHICLES, AND FOR
- 12 PURCHASING FIREFIGHTING APPARATUS EQUIPMENT, AMBULANCES, AND
- 13 RESCUE VEHICLES, PROTECTIVE AND COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT, AND
- 14 ANY OTHER ACCESSORY EQUIPMENT NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER
- 15 PERFORMANCE OF SUCH ORGANIZATIONS' DUTIES, " AND SUBSECTION (E)
- 16 OF SECTION 18.1 OF THIS ACT BY PROVIDING FOR LOANS TO VOLUNTEER
- 17 FIRE, AMBULANCE AND RESCUE COMPANIES TO PROTECT THE LIVES AND
- 18 PROPERTY OF THE CITIZENS OF THE COMMONWEALTH PURSUANT TO AND TO
- 19 EXECUTE THE ABOVE FAVORABLE REFERENDA. THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HAS
- 20 DETERMINED THAT VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES ARE MOST IN NEED OF
- 21 LOANS, AND THEREFOR INTENDS THAT, TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, A
- 22 SIGNIFICANT PORTION OF THE VOLUNTEER COMPANIES LOAN FUND BE USED
- 23 TO PROVIDE LOANS TO VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES AND THAT THE
- 24 BALANCE BE ALLOCATED TO PROVIDE LOANS TO VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE AND
- 25 VOLUNTEER RESCUE COMPANIES. THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY INTENDS THAT
- 26 LOANS PROVIDED UNDER THIS ACT BE USED TO REPLACE OUTMODED OR
- 27 UNSAFE EQUIPMENT AND BUILDINGS OF VOLUNTEER COMPANIES, AND THAT
- 28 LOANS BE PROVIDED TO VOLUNTEER COMPANIES WHICH ARE EXPERIENCING
- 29 A NEED FOR EQUIPMENT OR FACILITIES TO MEET AN INCREASING DEMAND
- 30 FOR A HIGHER LEVEL OF SERVICE IN THE COMMUNITIES WHICH THEY

- 2 SECTION 2. SECTION 4(A)(1) OF THE ACT, AMENDED MAY 11, 1982 <--
- 3 (P.L.407, NO.118) AND JULY 11, 1990 (P.L.415, NO.100), IS
- 4 AMENDED TO READ:
- 5 SECTION 4. ASSISTANCE TO VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES, AMBULANCE
- 6 SERVICE AND RESCUE SQUADS. -- (A) THE DEPARTMENT IS HEREBY
- 7 AUTHORIZED, UPON APPLICATION OF ANY VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY,
- 8 VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICE AND VOLUNTEER RESCUE SQUAD, TO MAKE
- 9 LOANS TO SAID VOLUNTEER COMPANIES FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
- 10 (1) ESTABLISHING OR MODERNIZING FACILITIES THAT HOUSE FIRE
- 11 FIGHTING EQUIPMENT, AMBULANCE OR RESCUE VEHICLES. THE AMOUNT OF
- 12 A LOAN FOR ESTABLISHING OR MODERNIZING FACILITIES MADE TO ANY
- 13 ONE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, AMBULANCE SERVICE OR RESCUE SQUAD
- 14 SHALL NOT EXCEED 50% OF THE TOTAL COST OF THE FACILITIES OR
- 15 MODERNIZATION OR [\$50,000] \$200,000, WHICHEVER IS LESS, AND A
- 16 NOTARIZED FINANCIAL STATEMENT FILED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) SHALL
- 17 SHOW THAT THE APPLICANT HAS AVAILABLE 20% OF THE TOTAL COST OF
- 18 THE FACILITIES IN UNOBLIGATED FUNDS. PROCEEDS OF THE LOAN SHALL
- 19 BE USED ONLY FOR PURPOSES OF LAND ACQUISITION OR CONSTRUCTION,
- 20 AND SHALL NOT BE USED FOR PAYMENT OF FEES FOR DESIGN, PLANNING,
- 21 PREPARATION OF APPLICATIONS, OR ANY OTHER COST NOT DIRECTLY
- 22 ATTRIBUTABLE TO LAND ACQUISITION OR CONSTRUCTION.

- 24 SECTION $\frac{2}{3}$. SECTION $\frac{6}{4}$ OF THE ACT IS AMENDED TO READ:

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- 25 Section 6. Powers and Duties of the Department.--(a) The
- 26 powers and duties of the department shall be:
- 27 (1) to appoint agents, employees, necessary to the
- 28 administration of this act, and to prescribe their duties and to
- 29 fix their compensation within the limitations provided by law;
- 30 (2) to accept grants from the Federal Government and any

- 1 other individual, agency, or government for use in the Volunteer
- 2 Companies Loan Fund;
- 3 (3) to loan money over a term of years, but in no case in
- 4 excess of [ten] 15 years; and
- 5 (4) to promulgate such rules and regulations as it deems
- 6 necessary to carry out its powers and duties [of] under this
- 7 act.

- 9 Section 2 3 + 4. Sections 7, 11(A), 18(b) and 19 of the act,
- 10 amended May 11, 1982 (P.L.407, No.118), are amended to read:
- 11 Section 7. Authority to Borrow.--Pursuant to the provisions
- 12 of section 7(a)(3) of Article VIII of the Pennsylvania
- 13 Constitution and the referenda approved by the electorate on
- 14 November 4, 1975 [and], November 3, 1981 and November 6, 1990,
- 15 the Governor, Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby
- 16 authorized and directed to borrow, on the credit of the
- 17 Commonwealth, money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of
- 18 [\$25,000,000] \$50,000,000 to implement this act, the act of
- 19 September 25, 1975 (P.L.296, No.95), entitled "An act
- 20 authorizing the indebtedness, with the approval of the electors,
- 21 of ten million dollars for loans to volunteer fire companies,
- 22 volunteer ambulance services and volunteer rescue squads for the
- 23 purpose of establishing or modernizing facilities to house fire
- 24 fighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles,
- 25 and for purchasing new fire fighting apparatus equipment,
- 26 ambulances, and rescue vehicles, protective and communications
- 27 equipment, and any other accessory equipment necessary for the
- 28 proper performance of such organizations' duties, " and the act
- 29 of June 30, 1981 (P.L.138, No.44), entitled "An act authorizing
- 30 the indebtedness, with the approval of the electors, of

- 1 \$15,000,000 for loans to volunteer fire companies, volunteer
- 2 ambulance services and volunteer rescue squads for the purpose
- 3 of establishing or modernizing facilities to house firefighting
- 4 apparatus equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles, and for
- 5 purchasing firefighting apparatus equipment, ambulances, and
- 6 rescue vehicles, protective and communications equipment, and
- 7 any other accessory equipment necessary for the proper
- 8 performance of such organizations' duties."
- 9 SECTION 11. DISPOSITION AND USE OF PROCEEDS.--(A) THE
- 10 PROCEEDS REALIZED FROM THE SALE OF BONDS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF
- 11 THIS ACT SHALL BE PAID INTO THE VOLUNTEER COMPANIES LOAN FUND
- 12 AND ARE SPECIFICALLY DEDICATED TO THE PURPOSES OF THE REFERENDA
- 13 OF NOVEMBER 4, 1975 [AND], NOVEMBER 3, 1981 AND NOVEMBER 6,
- 14 1990, AS IMPLEMENTED BY THIS ACT. THE MONEYS SHALL BE PAID BY
- 15 THE STATE TREASURER PERIODICALLY TO THOSE DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES,
- 16 OR AUTHORITIES AUTHORIZED TO EXPEND SAME AT SUCH TIMES AND IN
- 17 SUCH AMOUNTS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO SATISFY THE FUNDING NEEDS OF

- 20 Section 18. Temporary Financing Authorization. -- * * *
- 21 (b) All temporary borrowings made under the authority of
- 22 this section shall be evidenced by notes of the Commonwealth,
- 23 which shall be issued from time to time for such amounts not
- 24 exceeding in the aggregate the sum of [\$25,000,000] \$50,000,000
- 25 in such form and in such denominations, and subject to such
- 26 terms and conditions of issue, prepayment or redemption and
- 27 maturity, rate of interest, and time of payment of interest, as
- 28 the issuing officials shall direct. All notes issued under the
- 29 authority of this section shall bear the facsimile signatures of
- 30 the issuing officials and a facsimile of the Great Seal of the

- 1 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and shall be countersigned by
- 2 [two] one duly authorized [officers] officer of a duly
- 3 authorized loan and transfer agent of the Commonwealth.

- 5 Section 19. Appropriation.--The sum of [\$25,000,000]
- 6 \$50,000,000 or as much thereof as is able to be borrowed by
- 7 temporary financing or by bonds, is hereby appropriated to the
- 8 Volunteer Companies Loan Fund for the purposes set forth in this
- 9 act. The General Assembly may make appropriations from time to
- 10 time to the Volunteer Companies Loan Fund or to the department
- 11 to carry out the purposes of this act which appropriations shall
- 12 be continuing appropriations and shall not lapse.
- 13 SECTION 5. THE SUM OF \$100,000, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE <-
- 14 NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE STATE FIRE COMMISSIONER
- 15 TO ADMINISTER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT. THIS SUM SHALL BE IN
- 16 ADDITION TO FUNDS APPROPRIATED UNDER SECTION 225 OF THE ACT OF
- 17 AUGUST 4, 1991 (P.L. , NO.7A), KNOWN AS THE GENERAL
- 18 APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1991.
- 19 Section 3-4 6. This act shall take effect immediately. <--
