14	Section 1. Section 11(a) of the act of January 14, 1952
15	(1951 P.L.1898, No.522), known as the Funeral Director Law, is

17	Section 11. Refusal; Suspension; Revocation(a) The
18	board, by a majority vote thereof, may refuse to grant, refuse
19	to renew, suspend or revoke a license of any applicant or
20	licensee, whether originally granted under this act or under any

- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
