11	Section 1. Section 2603-B of the act of March 10, 1949
12	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
13	amended by adding a subsection to read:
14	Section 2603-B. Powers and Duties of the Board* * *
15	(j.1) The board shall require every person applying for
16	certification as a teacher, administrator or educational
17	specialist to show evidence of the successful completion of a
18	three (3) credit-hour course in the use and abuse of chemical
19	substances, including methods of identification of such abuse
20	within the school community.
