AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," providing that the State Board of
6 Education shall require persons seeking certification to have
7 certain training relating to the use and abuse of chemical
8 substances.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Section 2603-B of the act of March 10, 1949
12 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
13 amended by adding a subsection to read:

14 Section 2603-B. Powers and Duties of the Board.--* * *

15 (j.1) The board shall require every person applying for
16 certification as a teacher, administrator or educational
17 specialist to show evidence of the successful completion of a
18 three (3) credit-hour course in the use and abuse of chemical
19 substances, including methods of identification of such abuse
20 within the school community.

21 * * *

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
