## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act defining the liability of an employer to pay damages for injuries received by an employe in the course of employment; establishing an elective schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the determination of liability and compensation thereunder; and
- determination of liability and compensation thereunder; and prescribing penalties, providing for additional coverage.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known
- 11 as The Pennsylvania Workmen's Compensation Act, reenacted and
- 12 amended June 21, 1939 (P.L.520, No.281), is amended by adding a
- 13 section to read:
- 14 Section 602. Any injury sustained by a law enforcement
- 15 officer, while not on duty, which is the result of activities or
- 16 actions authorized or required by regulation, including, but not
- 17 limited to, the possession of service-related firearms, shall
- 18 not be barred from compensation.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
