- The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and amended July 10,
- 10 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), is amended by adding a section to read:
- 11 Section 599-B. Litter Enforcement Officers. -- The board of
- township supervisors may appoint, remove or suspend persons for 12
- 13 the purpose of enforcing township ordinances and State statutes
- relating to the control of litter, including, but not limited 14
- 15 to, the provisions of the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97),
- 16 known as the "Solid Waste Management Act." The sum of fifty
- dollars shall be assessed in addition to other penalties 17
- provided by law for each violation, the proceeds of which shall 18

- 1 support litter enforcement programs within the township.
