AN ACT

- 1 Providing for participation in the National Association of
 - Insurance Commissioners Insurance Regulatory Information
- 3 System.

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- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Definitions.
- 7 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 8 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 9 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 10 "Commissioner." The Insurance Commissioner of the
- 11 Commonwealth.
- 12 "Department." The Department of Insurance of the
- 13 Commonwealth.
- 14 "NAIC." The National Association of Insurance Commissioners.
- 15 Section 2. Filing requirements.
- 16 (a) General rule.--Each domestic, foreign and alien insurer
- 17 who is authorized to transact insurance in this Commonwealth
- 18 shall annually, on or before March 1 of each year, file with the

- 1 National Association of Insurance Commissioners a copy of its
- 2 annual statement convention blank, along with such additional
- 3 filings as prescribed by the commissioner for the preceding
- 4 year. The information filed with the NAIC shall be in the same
- 5 format and scope as that required by the commissioner and shall
- 6 include the signed jurat page and the actuarial certification.
- 7 Any amendments and addenda to the annual statement filing
- 8 subsequently filed with the commissioner shall also be filed
- 9 with the NAIC.
- 10 (b) Foreign insurers.--Foreign insurers that are domiciled
- 11 in a state which has a law substantially similar to subsection
- 12 (a) shall be deemed in compliance with this section.
- 13 Section 3. Immunity.
- 14 In the absence of actual malice, members of the NAIC, their
- 15 duly authorized committees, subcommittees and task forces, their
- 16 delegates, NAIC employees, and all others charged with the
- 17 responsibility of collecting, reviewing, analyzing and
- 18 disseminating the information developed from the filing of the
- 19 annual statement convention blanks shall be acting as agents of
- 20 the commissioner under the authority of this act and shall not
- 21 be subject to civil liability for libel, slander or any other
- 22 cause of action by virtue of their collection, review and
- 23 analysis or dissemination of the data and information collected
- 24 from the filings required under this act.
- 25 Section 4. Confidentiality.
- 26 All financial analysis ratios and examination synopses
- 27 concerning insurance companies that are submitted to the
- 28 department by the National Association of Insurance
- 29 Commissioners Insurance Regulatory Information System are
- 30 confidential and may not be disclosed by the department.

- 1 Section 5. Revocation of certificate of authority.
- 2 The commissioner may suspend, revoke or refuse to renew the
- 3 certificate of authority of any insurer failing to file its
- 4 annual statement when due or within any extension of time which
- 5 the commissioner, for good cause, may have granted.
- 6 Section 6. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
