9	§ 3315. Disposition of fines and penalties.
10	[All] (a) General ruleExcept as provided in subsection
11	(b), all fines imposed, and all penalties recovered, under the
12	provisions of this part, shall be paid to the commission, and by
13	it paid into the State Treasury, through the Department of
14	Revenue, to the credit of the General Fund.
15	(b) Fines returned to ratepayersThe commission shall have
16	the power and may order any public utility assessed a civil
17	penalty under this title for any violations relating to the
18	quantity or quality of public utility service rendered to rebate

- 1 all or any portion of that civil penalty to affected ratepayers
- 2 <u>in the form of a credit against future bills.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
