AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act to empower cities of the second class A, and third class, boroughs, incorporated 3 towns, townships of the first and second classes including 4 5 those within a county of the second class and counties of the 6 second class A through eighth classes, individually or jointly, to plan their development and to govern the same by 7 zoning, subdivision and land development ordinances, planned 8 9 residential development and other ordinances, by official maps, by the reservation of certain land for future public 10 purpose and by the acquisition of such land; to promote the 11 conservation of energy through the use of planning practices 12 13 and to promote the effective utilization of renewable energy 14 sources; providing for the establishment of planning commissions, planning departments, planning committees and 15 16 zoning hearing boards, authorizing them to charge fees, make 17 inspections and hold public hearings; providing for 18 mediation; providing for transferable development rights; 19 providing for appropriations, appeals to courts and penalties 20 for violations; and repealing acts and parts of acts," 21 providing for the use of planning assistance grants. 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 The act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), known Section 1.
- 25 as the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, reenacted and
- 26 amended December 21, 1988 (P.L.1329, No.170), is amended by
- 27 adding a section to read:

- 1 Section 106.1. Use of Planning Assistance Grants. -- A grant
- from the Department of Community Affairs to a governing body for 2
- 3 planning assistance may be used for development or amendment of
- the text and map of a zoning ordinance, as well as for 4
- development or amendment of the comprehensive plan. 5
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
