Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for issuance and content of 3 driver's license. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 1510 SECTIONS 1510 AND 1609 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is ARE amended by adding a subsection SUBSECTIONS to read: § 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license. 10 11 (f) Exemption. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), the department shall not refuse to issue a driver's license 12 13 to an otherwise eligible person who fails to submit a Social Security number, provided that he is exempt from obtaining a 14 15 Social Security number under Federal law. 16 (F) WAIVER. -- NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION

- 1 (A), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A DRIVER'S LICENSE TO AN
- 2 OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE PERSON WHO HAS NO SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IF
- 3 THE PERSON SUBMITS A WAIVER OBTAINED FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT
- 4 PERMITTING HIM NOT TO HAVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. THE
- 5 DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE OTHER IDENTIFIERS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 6 LIMITED TO, A TAXPAYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, BEFORE ISSUING THE
- 7 LICENSE.

- 10 (D) WAIVER.--NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION
- 11 (A)(4), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT REQUIRE A SOCIAL SECURITY
- 12 NUMBER ON THE APPLICATION FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE OF A
- 13 PERSON WHO SUBMITS A WAIVER OBTAINED FROM THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY
- 14 ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
- 15 PERMITTING HIM NOT TO HAVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. IF THE
- 16 WAIVER REQUIRES THE PERSON TO HAVE SOME OTHER SORT OF IDENTIFIER
- 17 <u>IN PLACE OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, THE IDENTIFIER MUST BE</u>
- 18 INDICATED ON THE APPLICATION.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days
