4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 2524 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 2524. Protective material required.
9	(a) General ruleUnless further restricted by regulations
10	of the commission, every person hunting for or assisting to hunt
11	for deer, bear or woodchucks shall wear either a minimum of 250
12	square inches of daylight fluorescent orange-colored material on
13	the back and front combined or, in lieu thereof, a hat of the
14	same color material. The material shall be worn so it is visible
15	in a 360-degree arc. [Unless] <u>Except as provided in subsection</u>
16	(b) and unless otherwise specified by regulations of the
17	commission, the provision of this section shall not apply to any
18	season for using muzzle-loading firearms only or season for

1 using bows and arrows only.

2 (b) Fall archery season for deer. -- Whenever the fall archery 3 season for deer coincides with or continues into the regular fall season for taking small game, any person hunting for or 4 5 assisting to hunt for deer shall wear either a minimum of 100 square inches of daylight fluorescent orange-colored material on 6 the back or front combined or, in lieu thereof, a hat of the 7 same color material. 8 [(b)] (c) Penalty.--A violation of this section is a summary 9 offense of the fifth degree. 10

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1992.
