## AN ACT

Section 1797(b)(3) of Title 75 of the 6 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 1797. Customary charges for treatment. 9 10 (b) Peer review plan for challenges to reasonableness and necessity of treatment. --11 12 13 (3) Pending determinations by PRO.--If the insurer 14 challenges within 30 days of receipt of a bill for medical 15 treatment or rehabilitative services, the insurer [need not] 16 shall, nevertheless, pay the provider subject to the challenge [until a determination has been made by the PRO] 17 pending receipt by the provider of the determination of the 18

- 1 PRO or until five days after the PRO's determination has been
- 2 mailed to the provider, whichever occurs first. The insured
- may not be billed for any treatment, accommodations, products 3
- or services during the peer review process. 4

- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
