AN ACT

Amending the act of July 18, 1935 (P.L.1314, No.411), entitled, as amended, "An act authorizing the utilization of the 2 3 Pennsylvania State Police Academy for training persons to act as policemen in the political subdivisions of the 5 Commonwealth; prescribing the qualifications for admission of such persons to such school; providing for the payment of 7 certain costs by such students; conferring certain powers upon the Pennsylvania State Police; and making an appropriation," increasing the age limit for veterans who may 9 10 enter the State Police Academy. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1.
