AN ACT
Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing special plates for recipients of Bronze Star Medals and Silver Star Medals.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
§ 1350. Special plates for recipients of Bronze Star Medals and
Silver Star Medals.
Upon application of any person who is a recipient of a Bronze
Star Medal or a Silver Star Medal, the department shall issue to
such person a special registration plate designating the vehicle
so licensed as belonging to a person who is a recipient of a
Bronze Star Medal or a Silver Star Medal. The special
registration plate may be used only on one passenger vehicle or one other vehicle with a registered gross weight of not more

17 than 9,000 pounds.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
