AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20 commissions shall be determined," imposing additional powers
21 and duties on the Department of Labor and Industry relating
22 to pressure relief valves on swimming pool filters.

23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
24 hereby enacts as follows:

25 Section 1. Section 2202(i) of the act of April 9, 1929
26 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929,
27 added April 12, 1956 (1955 P.L.1467, No.481), is amended and the

1 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

2 Section 2202. Inspection and Administration.--The Department
3 of Labor and Industry shall have the power, and its duty shall
4 be:

5 * * *

6 (i) To annually inspect emergency lighting systems,
7 sprinkler systems, and fire alarm systems, in all buildings
8 owned or operated by the Commonwealth, and to report the
9 respective operating conditions thereof to the departments of
10 the Commonwealth having jurisdiction of the buildings[.];

11 (j) To require that every swimming pool filter tank having a
12 capacity in excess of ten gallons be equipped with an automatic
13 pressure relief valve set to operate at a pressure established
14 by the department to prevent explosion or rupture of the filter
15 or tank or the connecting piping. This subsection shall apply to
16 all swimming pools in use on or after the effective date of this
17 subsection.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1993.
