A RESOLUTION

1 Designating November 1992, as "Armed Forces History Month."

2 WHEREAS, The history of the United States of America reveals
3 that our peaceful tranquility and pursuit of happiness have
4 often been threatened or interrupted by the enemies of freedom;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, Millions of Pennsylvania's sons and daughters have
7 defended our nation during peace and armed conflict; and

8 WHEREAS, Military history and the sacrifices of our veterans
9 have been an integral part of America's past; and

10 WHEREAS, It is important for Pennsylvanians to understand our
11 military history and its role in keeping America free so our
12 citizens can enjoy the blessings of liberty; and

13 WHEREAS, Learning military history better prepares us to
14 understand the complex problems which will be associated with
15 the global challenges we will face in the future; therefore be
16 it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the

1 Secretary of Education, Department of Education and the
2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to encourage the integration of
3 military history and the contributions of our veterans into
4 Pennsylvania's social studies curriculum and further directs
5 that November 1992, is designated as "Armed Forces History
6 Month."
