## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 21, 1957 (P.L.390, No.212), entitled 2 "An act requiring certain records of the Commonwealth and its 3 political subdivisions and of certain authorities and other 4 agencies performing essential governmental functions, to be 5 open for examination and inspection by citizens of the 6 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; authorizing such citizens under 7 certain conditions to make extracts, copies, photographs or photostats of such records; and providing for appeals to the 8 courts of common pleas, " adding certain educational 9 10 institutions to the definition of "agency." The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- 13 Section 1. Section 1(1) of the act of June 21, 1957
- 14 (P.L.390, No.212), referred to as the Right-to-Know Law, is
- 15 amended to read:
- 16 Section 1. In this act the following terms shall have the
- 17 following meanings:
- 18 "Agency." Any department, board or commission of the (1)
- executive branch of the Commonwealth, any political subdivision 19
- 20 of the Commonwealth, the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, or

- 1 any State or municipal authority or similar organization created
- 2 by or pursuant to a statute which declares in substance that
- 3 such organization performs or has for its purpose the
- 4 performance of an essential governmental function. The term
- 5 <u>shall include: Lincoln University; The Pennsylvania State</u>
- 6 <u>University; the University of Pittsburgh; Temple University; the</u>
- 7 <u>State System of Higher Education and all of its member</u>
- 8 <u>institutions; and all community colleges.</u>

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
