AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 21, 1957 (P.L.390, No.212), entitled  
2 "An act requiring certain records of the Commonwealth and its  
3 political subdivisions and of certain authorities and other  
4 agencies performing essential governmental functions, to be  
5 open for examination and inspection by citizens of the  
6 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; authorizing such citizens under  
7 certain conditions to make extracts, copies, photographs or  
8 photostats of such records; and providing for appeals to the  
9 courts of common pleas," adding certain educational  
10 institutions to the definition of "agency."

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. Section 1(1) of the act of June 21, 1957  
14 (P.L.390, No.212), referred to as the Right-to-Know Law, is  
15 amended to read:

16 Section 1. In this act the following terms shall have the  
17 following meanings:

18 (1) "Agency." Any department, board or commission of the  
19 executive branch of the Commonwealth, any political subdivision  
20 of the Commonwealth, the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, or

1 any State or municipal authority or similar organization created  
2 by or pursuant to a statute which declares in substance that  
3 such organization performs or has for its purpose the  
4 performance of an essential governmental function. The term  
5 shall include: Lincoln University; The Pennsylvania State  
6 University; the University of Pittsburgh; Temple University; the  
7 State System of Higher Education and all of its member  
8 institutions; and all community colleges.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
