AN ACT

Amending the act of June 30, 1992 (P.L. , No.8A), entitled 2 "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of 3 the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1992, to June 30, 1993, for certain institutions and organizations, and for the payment of bills 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992; to provide appropriations from the 9 State Lottery Fund, the Pennsylvania Economic Revitalization Fund, the Energy Conservation and Assistance Fund, the 10 Hazardous Material Response Fund, The State Stores Fund, the 11 12 Milk Marketing Fund and the Emergency Medical Services 13 Operating Fund to the Executive Department; to provide 14 appropriations from the Judicial Computer System Augmentation 15 Account to the Judicial Department; to provide appropriations from the Motor License Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 1992, 16 to June 30, 1993, for the proper operation of the several 17 18 departments of the Commonwealth and the Pennsylvania State 19 Police authorized to spend Motor License Fund moneys; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds to the 20 21 Executive and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth and 22 for the establishment of restricted receipt accounts for the 23 fiscal year July 1, 1992, to June 30, 1993, and for the 24 payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992; to provide for the 25 26 additional appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive 27 Department of the Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 1991, to June 30, 1992, and for the payment of bills incurred 28 and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending 29
