## A JOINT RESOLUTION

> Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for a limit on operating budget increases.
> The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
> hereby resolves as follows:
> Section 1 . The following amendment to the Constitution of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
> That section 13 of Article VIII be amended to read:
> S 13.
(a) Operating budget appropriations made by the General Assembly shall not exceed the actual and estimated revenues and surplus available in the same fiscal year.
(b) The General Assembly shall adopt a capital budget for the ensuing fiscal year.
(c) (1) Any increase in an operating budget from that budget of the immediately prior fiscal year shall not exceed the average percentage increase in the personal income of the
residents of this Commonwealth for the prior fiscal year, as
calculated by the Department of Revenue and certified by the
Auditor General.
(2) An increase in the operating budget over the limit
prescribed in clause (1) may occur only by a vote of two-thirds
of all the members elected to each House.
