## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for insurance fraud.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 4117(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 7 § 4117. Insurance fraud.
- 8 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits an offense if the
- 9 person does any of the following:

- 11 (8) Prepares or makes any written or oral statement
- intended to be presented to any insurer or producer for the
- 13 purpose of obtaining a motor vehicle insurance policy,
- 14 stating that the person to be insured resides or is domiciled
- in any location other than the location where that person
- 16 actually resides or is domiciled.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
