9	repeals, " further providing for approval of chiropractic	
10	colleges.	
11	PROVIDING FOR THE ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN PERSONS FOR LICENSURE	<

14	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

15	hereby enacts as follows:	
16	Section 1. Section 303(a) of the act of December 16, 1986	<
17	(P.L.1646, No.188), known as the Chiropractic Practice Act, is	
18	amended to read:	
19	Section 303. Approval of chiropractic colleges.	
20	(a) Approval of colleges. The board shall approve any	
21	chiropractic college which is accredited by a chiropractic	
22	accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of	

- 1 Education or the Council on Post Secondary Accreditation, but
- 2 the board shall not approve any chiropractic college which is
- 3 not so accredited. If an accredited chiropractic college's
- 4 accrediting agency loses its recognition by the United States
- 5 Department of Education, a student who had matriculated and
- 6 begun his studies at the college prior to the effective date of
- 7 the loss of recognition shall, upon completion of his degree
- 8 program, be admitted to the licensing examination and shall be
- 9 eligible for licensure if he otherwise satisfies the
- 10 <u>requirements of this act, provided that:</u>
- 11 (1) the college continues to be accredited by the
- 12 <u>chiropractic accrediting agency;</u>
- 13 <u>(2) the college continues to have the authority, under</u>
- 14 <u>the laws of the state in which it is located, to grant the</u>
- 15 <u>doctor of chiropractic (D.C.) degree; and</u>
- 16 <u>(3) the student graduates prior to December 31, 1996.</u>

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
- 19 SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR LICENSURE.
- 20 IF AN ACCREDITED CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE'S ACCREDITING AGENCY
- 21 LOSES, OR HAS LOST, ITS RECOGNITION BY THE UNITED STATES
- 22 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, A STUDENT WHO HAD MATRICULATED AND
- 23 BEGUN HIS STUDIES AT THE COLLEGE PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 24 THE LOSS OF RECOGNITION SHALL, UPON COMPLETION OF HIS DEGREE
- 25 PROGRAM, BE ADMITTED TO THE CHIROPRACTIC LICENSING EXAMINATION
- 26 AND SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR LICENSURE TO PRACTICE CHIROPRACTIC IF
- 27 HE OTHERWISE SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ACT OF DECEMBER
- 28 16, 1986 (P.L.1646, NO.188), KNOWN AS THE CHIROPRACTIC PRACTICE
- 29 ACT, PROVIDED THAT:
- 30 (1) THE COLLEGE CONTINUES TO BE ACCREDITED BY THE

- 1 CHIROPRACTIC ACCREDITING AGENCY;
- 2 (2) THE COLLEGE CONTINUES TO HAVE THE AUTHORITY, UNDER
- 3 THE LAWS OF THE STATE IN WHICH IT IS LOCATED, TO GRANT THE
- 4 DOCTOR OF CHIROPRACTIC (D.C.) DEGREE; AND
- 5 (3) THE STUDENT GRADUATES PRIOR TO DECEMBER 31, 1996.
- 6 SECTION 2. NOTICE OF ACCREDITATION STATUS.
- 7 (A) REQUIREMENT. -- A CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE LOCATED IN THIS
- 8 COMMONWEALTH WHICH IS NOT ACCREDITED BY A CHIROPRACTIC
- 9 ACCREDITING AGENCY RECOGNIZED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
- 10 EDUCATION OR THE COUNCIL ON POST-SECONDARY ACCREDITATION SHALL
- 11 PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING WRITTEN DISCLOSURE TO APPLICANTS:
- 12 SECTION 501 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CHIROPRACTIC PRACTICE ACT
- 13 REQUIRES APPLICANTS FOR LICENSURE TO HAVE GRADUATED FROM
- 14 AN APPROVED COLLEGE OF CHIROPRACTIC. SECTION 303 OF THIS
- 15 SAME ACT STATES THAT AN APPROVED COLLEGE IS A COLLEGE
- 16 ACCREDITED BY A CHIROPRACTIC ACCREDITING AGENCY
- 17 RECOGNIZED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
- 18 OR THE COUNCIL ON POST-SECONDARY ACCREDITATION. THIS
- 19 COLLEGE IS NOT CURRENTLY AN APPROVED COLLEGE. EFFORTS ARE
- 20 BEING MADE TO OBTAIN APPROVAL. IF APPROVAL IS NOT
- 21 OBTAINED BY THE TIME YOU ARE APPLYING FOR LICENSURE, YOU
- 22 WILL NOT QUALIFY TO BE LICENSED IN PENNSYLVANIA.
- 23 (B) RECORD.--THE COLLEGE SHALL RETAIN A COPY OF THE
- 24 DISCLOSURE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) WHICH IS SIGNED BY THE
- 25 APPLICANT.
- 26 SECTION 3. REPEAL.
- 27 SECTION 303(A) OF THE ACT OF DECEMBER 16, 1986 (P.L.1646,
- 28 NO.188), KNOWN AS THE CHIROPRACTIC PRACTICE ACT, IS REPEALED
- 29 INSOFAR AS IT IS INCONSISTENT WITH THIS ACT.
- 30 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.
