AN ACT

Amending the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), entitled 2 "An act relating to unfair insurance practices; prohibiting unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts 3 and practices; and prescribing remedies and penalties, " 5 further prohibiting unfair practices relating to denial of certain coverage with multiple contracts of health insurance. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), known 9 10 as the Unfair Insurance Practices Act, is amended by adding a 11 section to read: 12 Section 5.1. Continuation of Coverage of Health Care 13 Policies .-- It shall be an unfair insurance practice and a violation of this act for the health care insurer of a person or 14 15 family to exclude from coverage any treatment, care or hospitalization for any injury, illness or condition that 16 17 occurred during any period of continuous or uninterrupted 18 coverage, even though such uninterrupted coverage consisted of one or more short-term policy or policies of health insurance. 19

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
