A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, further providing for security from searches
- 3 and seizures.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 8 of Article I be amended to read:
- 9 § 8. Security from searches and seizures.
- 10 The people shall be secure in their persons, houses, papers
- 11 and possessions from unreasonable searches and seizures, and no
- 12 warrant to search any place or to seize any person or things
- 13 shall issue without describing them as nearly as may be, nor
- 14 without probable cause, supported by oath or affirmation
- 15 subscribed to by the affiant. This right shall be construed in
- 16 conformity with the fourth amendment to the Constitution of the
- 17 United States, as interpreted by the United States Supreme
