1 Section 2. Information.

For six monthly billing cycles from the effective date of this act, all interexchange telecommunications carriers shall provide the customer with information in the carriers' monthly billing that the gross receipts line item surcharge is not a tax increase, but merely a disclosure of taxes paid by the customer. Section 3. Repeal.
