AN ACT

Providing for the adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Game Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Short title.
This act shall be known and may be cited as the Game Fund Capital Budget Act for 1993-1994.

Section 2. Total authorization.
The total authorization for the capital projects in the category of public improvement projects to be acquired by the Pennsylvania Game Commission, and to be financed from current revenues of the Game Fund pursuant to executive authorizations, shall be $\$ 962,000 \$ 555,000$.

Section 3. Itemization of Pennsylvania Game Commission capital projects.

The individual capital projects in the category of public

1 improvement projects to be acquired by the Pennsylvania Game 2 Commission, and to be financed from current revenues of the Game 3 Fund pursuant to executive authorizations, are hereby itemized, 4 together with their respective estimated costs, as follows:

5 (1) Elk County
(i) Land acquisition - 750 acres
(2) Mifflin County
(i) Land acquisition - 564 acres

(i) Iand acquisition - 1,016 acres 407,000 Section 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
