## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for aggravated
- 3 assault.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2702(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 2702. Aggravated assault.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of aggravated
- 10 assault if he:
- 11 (1) attempts to cause serious bodily injury to another,
- or causes such injury intentionally, knowingly or recklessly
- under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the
- 14 value of human life;
- 15 (2) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
- 16 recklessly causes serious bodily injury to a judge, district

- 1 <u>justice</u>, police officer, firefighter, county adult probation
- or parole officer, county juvenile probation or parole
- officer or an agent of the Pennsylvania Board of Probation
- 4 and Parole in the performance of duty or to an employee of an
- 5 agency, company or other entity engaged in public
- transportation, while in the performance of duty;
- 7 (3) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly
- 8 causes bodily injury to a <u>judge</u>, <u>district justice</u>, police
- 9 officer, firefighter or county adult probation or parole
- officer, county juvenile probation or parole officer or an
- 11 agent of the Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole in
- the performance of duty;
- 13 (4) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly
- causes bodily injury to another with a deadly weapon; or
- 15 (5) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly
- causes bodily injury to a teaching staff member, school board
- member, other employee or student of any elementary or
- 18 secondary publicly-funded educational institution, any
- 19 elementary or secondary private school licensed by the
- 20 Department of Education or any elementary or secondary
- 21 parochial school while acting in the scope of his or her
- 22 employment or because of his or her employment relationship
- 23 to the school.

- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
