AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 18, 1935 (P.L.1314, No.411), entitled,  
2 as amended "An act authorizing the utilization of the  
3 Pennsylvania State Police Academy for training persons to act  
4 as policemen in the political subdivisions of the  
5 Commonwealth; prescribing the qualifications for admission of  
6 such persons to such school; providing for the payment of  
7 certain costs by such students; conferring certain powers  
8 upon the Pennsylvania State Police; and making an  
9 appropriation," regulating the age of persons attending the  
10 Pennsylvania State Police Academy.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of July 18, 1935 (P.L.1314,  
14 No.411), entitled, as amended "An act authorizing the  
15 utilization of the Pennsylvania State Police Academy for  
16 training persons to act as policemen in the political  
17 subdivisions of the Commonwealth; prescribing the qualifications  
18 for admission of such persons to such school; providing for the  
19 payment of certain costs by such students; conferring certain  
20 powers upon the Pennsylvania State Police; and making an  
21 appropriation," amended June 29, 1959 (P.L.487, No.112), is

1 amended to read:

2 Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the Pennsylvania State  
3 Police shall have the power, and its duty shall be, to conduct  
4 at the Pennsylvania State Police Academy courses of instruction  
5 for the proper training of persons, not exceeding thirty-four  
6 years of age, to act as policemen for the several political  
7 subdivisions of this Commonwealth. Subject to the provisions of  
8 this act, the Commissioner of Pennsylvania State Police is  
9 hereby authorized to establish standards of proficiency,  
10 training and discipline for persons attending such school, and  
11 to issue certificates of qualification to graduates of the  
12 various courses of instruction. The Commissioner, with the  
13 approval of the Governor, shall employ such instructors and  
14 other employes as may be necessary for the purposes of this act.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
